Day 1 07 SEP 2019	<b>Kota Kinabalu – Singapore – Istanbul</b> 09:30am Gather at KKIA for flight checkin 12:10pm Depart Kota Kinabalu for Singapore by Silk Air flight (MI 391) 14:15pm Arrive Terminal 2 Singapore for transit at Terminal 3 for flight to Istanbul
Day 2 08 SEP 2019	<b>Istanbul – Bursa: (Lunch, Dinner)</b> 01:45am Depart Singapore for Istanbul, Turkey by Singapore Airlines flight (SQ 392) – Terminal 3 07:45am Upon arrival meeting with your tour director  Upon arrival meeting with your tour director and visit <b>Emirgan Tulip Garden</b> (only in April), it is largest Tulip flower garden in Turkey. Next, departure to first capital of Turkish people, Bursa and visit <b>Osman Gazi Mausoleum</b> and <b>Orhan Gazi Mausoleum</b> , we will start our Bursa tour after paying respect Ottoman dynasty founder Osman Gazi and his son Orhan Gazi Mausoleum. Visit <b>Ulucami (Grand Mosque)</b> – the largest Mosque in Bursa with the most striking example of Ottoman Turkish art and impressive calligraphic wall decorations from 1399 AD. Visit <b>Koza Han</b> , which means the "silk cocoon market". Koza Han was built in 1491 by sultan Beyazit II. It was both used as a caravanserai and a silk market because Bursa was the last stop on the great Silk Road from China. Since 1491, the Koza Han has remained the center of the silk industry and trade. Overnight in Bursa.
Day 3 09 SEP 2019	<b>Bursa – Kusadasi: (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)</b> After breakfast depart to Kusadasi and enjoy the <b>scenery of Aegean</b> Sea and Islands along the way. Aegean have safe harbors and bays. In ancient times, navigation through the sea was easier than travelling across the rough terrain of the Greek mainland. Next, visit <b>House of Virgin Mary</b> , it is located on Ephesus, the shrine of Virgin Mary enjoys a marvelous atmosphere hidden in the green. It is the place where mary may have spent her last days. Indeed, she may have come in the area together with Saint John, who spent several years in the area to spread Christianity. Visit <b>The Temple of Artemis</b> , it is known as one of the Seven Wonders of the ancient world. It has been built in the areas of in the areas of Ephesus on a flat area which has over the centuries turned into a swamp. Overnight in Kusadasi.
Day 4 10 SEP 2019	<b>Kusadasi – Pamukkale: (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)</b> After breakfast visit <b>Leather Outlet Center</b> for shopping. Next, we set off for Selcuk and explore <b>Ephesus ancient city</b> , one of the world's most outstanding archaeological sites. Walk in its well-preserved marble streets to the Library of Celsius, the Odeon, Grand Theatre, Temple of Hadrian, Roman Bath etc. Next, we depart for <b>Pamukkale (Cotton Castle)</b> , visit the extensive ruins of <b>Hierapolis &amp; Necropolis</b> - known for its thermal baths and health centre. Thereafter, see "Cotton Castle" or Pamukkale's magical and unique terraces & castles created by deposits of white limestone from thermal springs. Before check in our hotel we will stop at <b>Textile factory outlet center</b> for you the enjoy the shopping. Overnight and dinner in Pamukkale.

Day 5 11 SEP 2019	<p><b>Pamukkale – Konya: (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)</b></p> <p>Today, travel to Konya. Photo Stop a 700 year old <b>ancient caravanserai</b> (a ‘hotel’ for ancient traders and travelers on silk road). Next, <b>visit the museum</b> of 13<sup>th</sup> century Philosopher <b>Melvana Celeleddin-i Rumi</b>, which used to be the cloister for Mevlevi Dervishes. Mevlana was a philosopher and mystic of Islam, but not a Muslim of the orthodox type. His doctrine advocates unlimited tolerance, positive reasoning, goodness, charity and awareness through love. To him and to his disciples all religions are more or less truth. Looking with the same eye on Muslim, Jew and Christian alike, his peaceful and tolerant teaching has appealed to men of all sects and creeds. Dinner and overnight in Konya.</p>
Day 6 12 SEP 2019	<p><b>Konya – Cappadocia: (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)</b></p> <p>After breakfast we will depart to Cappadocia and upon arrival <b>we will visit The Goreme Valley, it is obviously the first sight to be visited by any traveler.</b> Next, get the rare chance to experience the beauty and work of Turkey’s handmade crafts through a turkish carpet weaving course. Following this, a visit to the <b>Pigeon Valley</b>. Photo stops will be made at <b>Uchisar “castle” village</b>, a fantasy-land of strange and wonderful works of man and nature. If time permits, visit one of the <b>local cave house</b>. Then, proceed to <b>Avanos Pottery Village</b>, set on the banks of the Kizilirmak (Red River). Finally, a chance to view turkish semi precious turkish turquoise ( the name given by Marco Polo which means color of Turks). Next, be enchanted by the <b>Underground City</b>, once a place of refuge for 15000 Christians. Witness the ancient bedrooms, church, meeting hall and food storage rooms in this eight-storey city connected by 30km of corridors and passageways. Overnight in Cappadocia.</p>
Day 7 13 SEP 2019	<p><b>Cappadocia – Ankara – Bolu: (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)</b></p> <p><u>Optional Hot air ballooning over the charming landscape during sun rise is optional this morning time.</u> This morning, drive pass picturesque <b>Salt Lake</b>. Dinner and overnight in Bolu.</p>
Day 8 14 SEP 2019	<p><b>Bolu – Istanbul: (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)</b></p> <p>After breakfast visit <b>Blue Mosque (Sultan Ahmet Mosque)</b>, a 16<sup>th</sup> century’s religious center and the only mosque in Istanbul with 6 minarets. <b>Hippodrome square</b> where horse carriage and gladiator fights took place during the Byzantian Empire. It is decorated today with an Egyptian Column, Serpentane Column. Next, visit <b>St. Sophia Museum</b>, a unique combination of Christianity and Islam religion in the same holding place. Next, <b>Topkapi Palace</b> – a museum palace with a wide collection of Porcelains, Treasuries, religious collect peace. It is the first Great Imperial Palace of Ottoman Dynasty. Overnight in Istanbul.</p> <p><b>** Grand Bazaar is closed on every Sunday.</b></p>
Day 9 15 SEP 2019	<p><b>Istanbul: (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)</b></p> <p>After breakfast. <b>Bosphorous Cruise trip</b>. Here, you will be able to soak in the sights and sounds of Turkey’s Asia and Europe sector as you cruise through this water channel that is the very beat of life in Istanbul. Witness the magnificent architecture of the buildings along the river and the interesting activities of our local people. We will get very chance of taking photo of <b>Rumeli Castle</b> and <b>Anatolia Castle</b> build by the conquerer of Istanbul in 1453 Next, continue to visit <b>Spice Market</b> (Egyptian Market), this marketplace was constructed in the 1660s as part of the New Mosque complex, with rents from the shops going to support the upkeep of the mosque and its charitable activities. It was called the Egyptian Market because it was famous for selling goods shipped in from Cairo.</p>
Day 10 16 SEP 2019	<p><b>Istanbul – Singapore : (Breakfast)</b></p> <p>After breakfast to the airport for your flight back home, bringing back wonderful memories and superb souvenirs from your Turkish vacation Later transfer to airport for flight home 13:30pm Depart Istanbul by Singapore flight (SQ 391)</p>
