## **5D4N Cambodia: Phnom Penh-Siem Reap Tour**

**Itinerary Code: CPR5D (Validity: 01 April 2017 – 30 Sept 2017)**

Phnom Penh, sitting on the confluence of three rivers, was long time considered as one of the loveliest French-built cities in Indochina. Unfortunately many buildings, in the recent past, endured the turbulent years of war. However the capital of the kingdom is rich of culture and has the most bustling markets in the country.

The monuments of Angkor are one of South East Asia's historical highlights and shouldn't be missed by tourists traveling in Cambodia. The sanctuaries represent the national pride of the Khmers and were listed in 1992 as a World Heritage site by the UNESCO. Built between the 9<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> centuries with extraordinary creativity, the temples belong doubtless to one of the world's architectural wonders.



### **DAY 01: Arrival Phnom Penh ( L D )**

Upon arrival Cambodia – Phnom Penh International airport, meet by our representative and transfer to check in hotel. After lunch, shopping at Russian Market, this market was firstly opened by Russian. After that, explore Mekong River by boat, you can experience sunset in front of royal Palace. Dinner at local restaurant.



### **DAY 02: Phnom Penh ( B L D )**

After breakfast at hotel, Tour start visit Independence Monument, Victory Mounument, **Norodom Sihanouk statue**, Wat Phnom, Daun Penh Status, Royal Palace and Silver Pagoda. After lunch, continue visit to **"Khmer Rouge"** prison Toul Sleng museum which is displays items of the inhuman acts of Pol Pot, free leisure at Central market to shop until your drop, Chaktomuk River. Dinner at local restaurant.

### **DAY 03: Phnom Penh / Siem Reap ( B L D )**

After breakfast at hotel, proceed to Siem Reap by Non stop Express bus or Coach (around 6hrs). Upon arrival Siem Reap meet by local tour guide and transfer to check in hotel. After lunch, tour start visit Wat Thmey (Killing Field), Then stop at the **WAR MEMORIAL MONUMENT**. Continue visit LES ARTISAN D'ANGKOR an handicraft center for your own shopping. Buffet dinner at local restaurant with "Apsara" traditional dance performance. Then proceed to night market for 1 hours.

**Noted:** Visit the Angkor Night Market The first, best and currently the only true night market in Siem Reap. Located in the heart of town, the Angkor Night Market opens in the mid-afternoon and stays open until at least midnight. The Market harbors more than 100 shops and stalls offering souvenirs, handicrafts, clothes, books, DVDs, electronics, jewelry, art and there's even a travel agent, 3D movies...The shopping atmosphere is peaceful and relaxing.



### **DAY 04: Siem Reap – Angkor Wat ( B L D )**

After breakfast at hotel, Tour start visit the South Gate of Angkor Thom – Bayon, Baphoun, Phimeanakas, Elephant Terrance and Terrance of the Leper King. After lunch, continue visit Grand temple – Angkor Wat, Taprohm Temple, Srah Srong and proceed to Pre Rup temples until sunset, Next visit Souvenir Shop. Dinner at local restaurant.

**Note:** During the visit of the Bakan tower of Angkor Wat temple, visitors are required to wear a proper attire, covering shoulders and knees as this temple is still considered as a sacred site (no short, miniskirt or short trousers). Children under twelve years old are not allowed to climb up this tower. It will be closed on the Buddhist Sabbath Days, the Buddhist religious days, four days a month in accordance with the Lunar Calendar

# 五天四夜柬埔寨-金边 / 暹粒(吴哥窟) 游览

**Itinerary Code: CPR5D (Validity: 01 April 2017 – 30 Sept 2017)**

**金边**是柬埔寨王国的首都，是全国最大的城市，地处柬埔寨中部平原，处于湄公河、洞里萨河和巴萨河的交汇处。金边是全国政治、经济、文化中心，也是国内、国际航空和水陆交通枢纽。

**暹粒**省位于柬埔寨西北部，该省文物古迹繁多，旅游资源丰富，共有古寺庙 292 个，被联合国教科文组织列为世界七大奇迹之一的著名吴哥古迹就坐落在暹粒市以北 6 公里处，[中南半岛](#)最大的淡水湖—[洞里萨湖](#)位于该省南端。旅游业、农业和[渔业](#)是该省的支柱产业。

## 第一天：抵达金边

(午晚餐)

抵达柬埔寨 - 金边国际机场，由导游接往住宿酒店。午餐后，前往俄罗斯市场购物，俄罗斯名称的由来，据说是市场最早是由俄罗斯人来开办，聚集了很多俄罗斯商人再此开店，但经过红高棉后，俄罗斯人就离开了。之后，乘船游览湄公河一个小时。晚餐于当地餐馆。

## 第二天：金边

(早午晚餐)

早餐于酒店后，团体开始参观独立纪念碑，胜利纪念碑，**西哈努克遗像**，塔子山，边婆遗像，柬埔寨皇宫和银阁寺。午餐后，继续参观波尔布罪恶馆，随之到中央市场尽情购物，让客享受到购物逛街的乐趣，之后参观四臂湾**参观纪念品店**和 Factory outlet Shop.晚餐于当地餐厅。

## 第三天：金边 / 暹粒

(早午晚餐)

早餐于酒店后，搭乘直通巴士往暹粒省(大概 6 个小时)。抵达暹粒后由导游接送往住宿酒店登记。午餐后，团体开始参观新寺庙，之后参观战争纪念碑。阿迪珊雕刻学院和手工艺品中心购物，自助晚餐以及欣赏柬埔寨民族舞蹈表演。之后再去夜市市场游逛一个小时。

**注意：参观吴哥夜市，暹粒目前唯一的夜市坐落在城市的中心。吴哥夜市从午后开始营业，直到凌晨。市场里有着 100 多间商店和摊位，提供纪念品，工艺品，衣服，书籍，DVD 光盘，电子产品，珠宝，艺术等等....**



## 第四天：暹粒 - 吴哥窟

(早午晚餐)

早餐于酒店后，团体开始参观大吴哥的南城，巴杨庙，**巴本寺**，空中宫殿，斗象台和悦兵台。午餐后，继续参观小吴哥庙，塔普伦殿和古代圣池 - 随之乘车前往**变身塔**欣赏美丽夕阳吴哥窟，美景一览无遗**参观纪念品店**。晚餐于当地餐馆。

**注意：参观吴哥窟期间，游客必须穿有袖上衣和长裤。（不能穿短裙或短裤）。**
